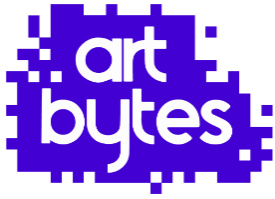
KS2 Football - Tillingbourne

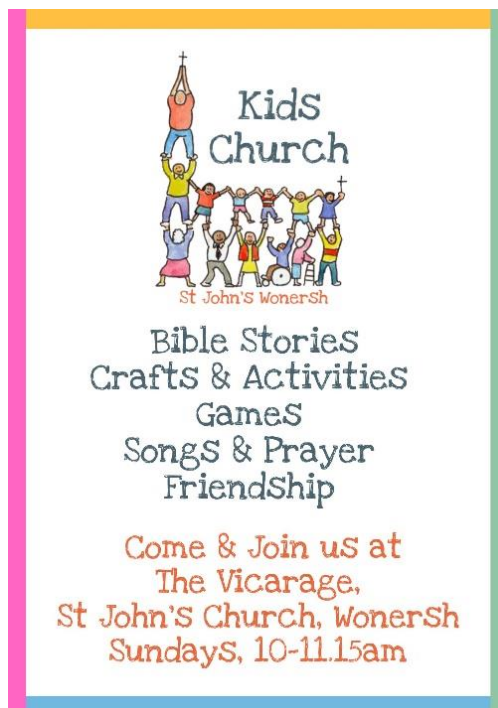
A thank you from St John's Church, Womersh
